

Knowledge Technology

The Company began life designing and marketing network communication products, network training and consultancy. In its early years as a result of its training and consultancy activities Knowledge Technology undertook a number of strategic consultancies that included the design and provision of the Northern Constabulary's wide area network (the largest geographical network in Europe), the Kirklees Metropolitan Borough Council Network and the Bank of England.

The Company became the contracted supplier of Ethernet adaptors and communication products under the CHEST contract supplying over 40,000 adaptors and £80m worth of networking equipment over a 10 year period.

Evolving into a major systems integrator, the Company undertook a number of major projects and management contracts that included the management of Vodafone Northern Ireland, the point of sale data collection for Whitbreads, Pizza Hut and Rover Group.

With the restructuring of the organisation and the transfer of its end user business into Lancare (a wholly owned subsidiary), the Company became a Value Added Distributor for hardware suppliers such as 3Com, Retix, CISCO, BICC and Ram Mobile Data and software manufacturers including Sun, VCS, CA and BMC.
