Piraeus owned what still is the largest access management system (marketed under the Athens trademark), which authorised every student in higher education to various data sets. The product was installed and supported in Australian University's, Danish libraries and commercial organisations such as Cannon.

The technology was sold to UK Academia in 2002 and now supplies secure access for all employees in the NHS, NHS Direct, UK Higher Education and a number of other major institutions around the world.
